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Protocol of Action

1. Cleaning, disinfection, and ventilation:

During the months that the school has been closed, thorough cleaning of the spaces has been carried out.

The floors have been cleaned with diluted bleach.

Tables, chairs, and materials have been cleaned with an alcohol-based sanitizing solution.

The ventilation will be carried out three times a day, before the morning entrance, at noon and at the end of the afternoon and for a minimum of 10 minutes

2. Students

The course will begin in person on September 14

During this period ENGLISH SCHOOL offers the following services:

- a.** Reception will be open to receive "early bird" children from 8am to 9am
- b.** Classes will take place under conditions as normal as possible
- c.** Lunch service
- d.** Extracurricular activities
- e.** Swimming activity
- f.** Afterschool care is offered from 4:45 pm to 6:00 pm

This will be the protocol of the school day (until further notice)



Requirements:

In order to return to school, students must meet the following requirements:

- **Absence of symptoms compatible with Covid-19** (fever, cough, respiratory distress, malaise, diarrhoea ...) or with any other infectious symptoms
- Have not been in close contact with confirmed positive or with clear symptoms in the previous 14 days.
- **Immunization schedule** up to date.
- **Mandatory mask** (change and daily washing)
- **Temperature must be checked before leaving home. If it is equal to or greater than 37°, they will not be able to attend school.**

3. Staff

All people who do not have a chronic disease such as the following may return to normal duties: respiratory, cardiovascular, immunological, diabetes, etc.

Teachers' Responsibilities:

- a. Follow the protocol of the plan established in the school.
- b. Ensure that students wash their hands before entering class and each time they go to the bathroom and / or come back from the playground
- c. **Kinder** students will do it in their classroom
- d. **Primary** students:
 - P2 and P4 in the playground
 - P1 in the bathroom next to their class
 - P3 in the one next to the library (1st floor)
 - P5 in the dining room
 - P6 in the bathroom on the 2nd floor
- e. **Secondary** students on the 3rd floor respecting the distances
- f. Ensure entrances and exits are staggered.



APPENDIX 1

A) Areas and spaces:

The school has decided that the children who come to the centre are placed as follows:

- Each one in their classroom.
- At specific times the laboratory, music and art rooms will be used by class groups.
- **Dining room: Kinder** students will eat in their dining room.

Primary school students will enter the main canteen in classes of there, in turns, maintaining an adequate distance between individuals and will not stay more than 30'. This will operate the same way for **Secondary**.

- **Playground:** All students will use the mask in the playground except Kindergarten, which is a stable group and will not be required.
- **The Kinder** pupils will follow a different schedule and use their own playground.
- **The Primary** students will use both play areas in a different time slot.
- **The Secondary** students, at a different time and not coinciding with the other classes, will use the playground and the ping-pong terrace.

B) Entrances, exits and playgrounds

- **Secondary** students will enter at 8:45 am and will go directly to their classroom and will exit via Main reception.
- **Primary classes** of P1, P2 and P3 will go to the Kinder playground. P4 to P6 will stay in the playground and when the bell rings each class-group will occupy a specific location marked on the ground. The students will then wash their hands with a teacher and access the classroom from the main reception.
- **Kinder** will need to enter their classroom unaccompanied. (For reasons of protocol, parents will not be able to enter the classroom).
- On leaving school in the afternoon, two exits will be used: **Kinder & Primary** Parents' will need to wait outside the school gates and will pick-up their child/children and make their way home.



KINDERGARTEN ADAPTATION.

• **During the first 3 days of school, a family member may accompany the student to class always wearing a mask and may only have contact with him/her maintaining a safe distance from the rest of the students.**

APPENDIX 2

1. PROTECTION AND PREVENTION MEASURES

- At the entrance to the building, there will be a sanitizing mat for students' shoes and a bottle of sanitizing gel for their hands.
- The temperature will be taken at the entrance of the school to all students
- Each classroom will have a bottle of hydroalcoholic sanitizing gel, a spray with disinfectant, thermometer, and a roll of paper.
- During the inter-classes' times, each teacher will disinfect his/her table and chair, open the windows for 10' for ventilation
- Students will wash their hands when entering class, when they go to the bathroom, and when they finish their playground time and return to the classroom.
- In **Kinder** classrooms, toys will be made of hard plastic that can be sanitized more easily.
- All students should bring a bottle of water in their backpack to avoid having to use glasses/cups.
- All students are obliged to wear a mask marked with their name and a spare.
- Playground hours will take place at different times and in separate areas.
- Cleaning will be carried out by the company LIMALIM with the use of specific cleaning products.

2. PROTOCOL OF ACTION IN CASE OF DETECTION OF APPEARANCE OF SYMPTOMATOLOGY ASSOCIATED WITH Covid-19:

In the case of appearance of symptoms in a student, the teacher should:

- Isolate the person or student in a separate room not under use.
- Notify the family, so they can pick them up.
- Call 061 to inform the appropriate authorities and that the existing protocol is put into action.
- Clean the space where the student has been.
- Send everyone home and disinfect the entire school, following the instructions of the Health Department
